- 1. Welcome
- 2. Dr. Alistair Windsor motioned to approve the minutes from February 2, 2023. Dr. Fatima Noguiera seconded the motion. All were in favor and so minutes were approved.
- 3. Announcements and Updates
 - A. UUC Updates from L. Menson-Furr
 - a. Syllabi format- All syllabi must have specific readings and texts listed.
 - b. CIP codes- There is now a CIP code change proposal in Curriculog. L. Menson-Furr asked that the council members familiarize themselves with CIP code terminology. Sociology is currently working on a CIP code change to move to a STEM designated code in alignment with their recent change to a BS from a BA.
 - c. The UUC met on February 10, 2023. A. Windsor served as L. Menson-Furr's proxy, voting on College of Engineering proposals on her behalf. A. Windsor shared that a PowerPoint overview was shown for the College of Education proposals, which will be voted on by the UUC directly in Curriculog as they become available.
