Prepare machine for use: adjust and check the condition of the guard and blade.	Pinching and laceration	on hazards.	 Keep fingers and hands away from pinch points and blade teeth. Wear gloves to handle blade. Adjust or replace blades as needed. 		
	Bodily injury.		 Check and replace any broken or damaged parts. Wear appropriate eye protection. 		
2. Start blower and saw.	Flying particles.		 Wear safety glasses or face shields (whichever is appropriate) to avoid eye injuries. Wear N95 dust mask to avoid respiratory irritation or damage. 		
	Hearing damage.		Wear ear plugs or ear muffs.		
3. Operating saw.	Bodily injury.		 Use guard properly. Use push bar for smaller materials. Adjust guard to no more than ¼-inch above top material. Tie back long hair and secure all loose clothing as needed. Wear safety shoes/boots (if necessary). 		
4. Align materials flat on table.	Pinching fingers or ha	ınds.	Keep fingers and hands away from pinch points.		
5. Procedure for malfunctioning or broken equipment.	Bodily injury.		 Obtain Accident Prevention Tag. Mark equipment "Do Not Use" and specify problem or hazard. Whenever possible isolate power source so equipment cannot be used. (Lockout/Tagout).
