



# INTERNATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

**Are you an incoming international student? Are you a top performer?  
Would you like a way to make college more affordable?**

If so, consider applying for the University of Memphis (UofM) International Merit Scholarship! This scholarship waives international fees so you will save by receiving the domestic out-of-state tuition rates. We value scholarly achievement and academic success, and want to attract the best and brightest students to join our cutting-edge programs and to learn from our world-renowned faculty.

The UofM selectively awards competitive merit-based scholarships for newly admitted degree-seeking international students on a J-1 or F-1 visa. This scholarship is designed to support international students who matriculate and take classes on the UofM campus as they work toward an undergraduate or graduate degree.



## AWARD PROCESS

Application deadline for an International Merit Scholarship is Jan. 10 for students starting in the spring semester.

## AWARD AMOUNT

Award amounts vary and cover the difference in cost of international and domestic non-Tennessee resident tuition rates. This scholarship cannot be combined with other UofM institutional scholarships. Exceptions are allowed for departmental funding.

# UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

## Eligibility Requirements for the International Merit Scholarship for Incoming Undergraduate Students

- 25 ACT or 1200 SAT equivalent
- OR
- 3.25 USA equivalent undergraduate degree GPA as determined by a credential evaluation agency (naces.org)

## Continuing Requirements to Maintain the International Merit Scholarship

- Full-time enrollment status
- 2.75 UofM GPA in first two semesters and 3.0 UofM GPA for subsequent semesters

The scholarship is a four-year (eight semesters), renewable scholarship requiring recipients to take a minimum of 12 credit hours per semester.

# GRADUATE STUDENTS

## Eligibility Requirements for the International Merit Scholarship for Incoming Graduate Students

- 310 GRE (with at minimum score of 150 in both the Verbal and Quantitative sections) and 2.5 AWA or equivalent GMAT scores

OR

- 3.25 USA equivalent undergraduate degree GPA as determined by a credential evaluation agency (naces.org) or relevant master's degree from an accredited and approved institution

## Continuing Requirements to Maintain the International Merit Scholarship

- Full-time enrollment status
- 3.0 UofM GPA all semesters

The scholarship is a two-year (four semesters), renewable scholarship requiring recipients to maintain full-time enrollment.
