WEBSITE REDESIGN OVERVIEW

The University of Memphis (UofM) is undergoing a comprehensive website redesign to enhance user experience, align with updated branding, and streamline content management. In partnership with Modern Campus, this project leverages its Content Management System (CMS) to ensure a seamless integration of templates and capabilities.

WEBSITE REDESIGN OVERVIEW (CONT.)

Project Timeline and Phases

The redesign is structured in two key phases to ensure a systematic and efficient process.

Phase 1: Website Design (8–9 Months)

Timeline: Began in August 2024 Objective: Establish the overall design direction, incorporating UofM branding into page designs. Current Status: UI (user interface) Design - The project is currently in the UI design stage, building upon foundational research and discovery. *Tasks in Phase 1:* Research and Discovery, UI Design (current phase, Front-End Build, Testing

Phase 2: CMS Implementation (3–4 Months)

Objective - Implement the approved designs into the Modern Campus CMS, creating templates and migrating content from the existing design. **Tasks in Phase 2:** Development, Training, User Acceptance Testing, Content Preparation and Migration, Go Live July 2025.

Web Services compiles a directory of microsites and collaborates with web developers to identify their scope and purpose. The goal is to establish clear functional ownership and designate technical maintainers, if applicable.

Content Cleanup - Web Services is partnering with the Marketing Department to address outdated or stale content to ensure a smooth migration. They aim to identify pages that have yet to be updated in over a year. Web Services will work with technical maintainers to clean up and update these pages before migration.
