Upon admission to program students should apply for the ILL-A licensure. Towards the end of the final semester of coursework, students must take the SLLA Praxis for ILL-B licensure. Taking and passing the SLLA Praxis for ILL-B licensure serves as the comprehensive examination for both the School Administration and Supervision masters program as well as the K-12 Educational Leadership graduate certificate.
