A CAREER IN DEMAND

In recent years the critical importance of effective supply chain management has been demonstrated on an ongoing basis. Hardly a day passes without the report of a supply chain disruption. Supplier shortages, manufacturing interruptions and logistics challenges are commonplace. In addition, with e-commerce on the rise, the way customers make and receive purchases continues to evolve, further complicating the process of moving products from development to delivery. Today, companies have an even greater need for qualified SCM professionals who are prepared to design and manage resilient supply chains that are capable of meeting these challenges.

SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT CAREER EARNING POTENTIAL

The Association for Supply Chain Management 2024 Salary Survey found that professionals with a bachelor's degree reported a median salary of \$100,000, which is about \$30,000 more than the national average for two-year, associate, bachelor's and master's degrees. Plus, 61% of respondents received additional cash compensation (bonus, profit sharing) with their salary.
