Graduate Choral Conductor

Karen Zeferino (b. 1996) was born in Maringá, Brazil, where she first studied piano with her father. She later explored piano, guitar, and choral singing at the UEM Music School, which inspired her to pursue a degree in conducting. While studying at the State University of Maringá, she served as an assistant conductor for various choirs and ensembles, including the UEM Flute and Strings Ensembles. In Brazil, Karen participated in masterclasses with renowned conductors like Marco Antonio da Silva Ramos, Alessandro Sangiorgi, and Abel Rocha. She also conducted performances at the Londrina Music Festival and with the OSUEL Orchestra. Karen pursued a Master of Music in Choral Conducting at the University of Missouri-Columbia (2021-23), where she was a teaching assistant for several choirs. She also attended masterclasses with distinguished conductors like Dr. Marques L.A. Garrett, Dr. Derrick Fox, and Rick Bjella. In July 2022, she conducted the Tacoma Symphony and Tacoma Symphony Voices during the Cascade Conducting Masterclass.

Collaborative Pianist

Amy Nguyen currently serves as the collaborative artist for the University of Memphis Choral Arts Department. Nguyen has performed throughout the country, including performances with the Independence Symphony, the Kansas City Symphony, and the Memphis Symphony Orchestra. She has played for the West TN Youth Chorus and the Collegiate School of Memphis.

Nguyen started her piano studies at the age of five. She earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree with Honors from Graceland University where she studied with Charles Schmidt. Under the tutelage of Richard Smith, she earned a Master of Music Degree from Central Missouri State University. She also studied with Betty Mallard at the University of Texas at Austin.
