

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

A Master of Public Health (MPH) with concentration in Epidemiology focuses more on epidemiology methods to prepare students as strong contributors to the community and society to improve public and population health.

As a CEPH accredited institution, students are eligible to take the CPH exam upon completion of their MPH core courses.

The program admission structure is as follows:

- a traditional 2-year program offered in-person/online with rolling admission available for fall, spring or summer.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

Through close work with professors and peers, students will develop competence in higher levels of community engagement and research responsibilities, including deeper understanding of the community and environmental factors involved in public health problems, epidemiology and biostatistics methods, evidence-based interventions and strong public health communication skills.
