- Undergraduate students interested in Public Health
- Minimum GPA of 3.25
- · Completed 60 credit hours



ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This program allows outstanding BSPH or undergraduate students to accelerate their path towards a Master of Public Health (MPH) by enrolling in graduate level courses during their junior and senior years. Students should consider the Accelerated Bachelor to Master of Public Health (ABM) early in their undergraduate career, in consultation with their academic advisors.

BSPH TO MPH

The ABM program prepares BSPH or undergraduate students to transition directly into the University of Memphis School of Public Health MPH degree program.

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

ABM students will develop skills in multidisciplinary fields of public health including biostatistics, epidemiology, social and behavioral science, environmental health and health policy.

IS THIS DEGREE FOR YOU?

The ABM program could be right for you if you are completing a BSPH or bachelor's degree and are considering a graduate degree in public health.

CURRICULUM

The four courses that an undergraduate should take to accelerate their path toward MPH attainment are:

PUBH 7180 | Foundations of Public Health

PUBH 7160 | Social and Behavioral Science Principles

PUBH 7150 | Biostatistical Methods I

PUBH 7170 | Epidemiology in Public Health I

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate students considering an accelerated graduate program must have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or greater and have completed at least 60 credit hours, some of which should be public health courses relevant to the BSPH degree.

To continue in the program past the BSPH, students must apply for full admission into the Graduate School and into the School of Public Health's MPH program.

Students in ABM programs can apply up to 12 hours of graduate coursework to both their undergraduate and graduate programs. However, graduate coursework will not apply toward the undergraduate GPA. Once a student has received a grade of "B" or better in eligible ABM courses and been accepted into the SPH MPH program, credit for these courses will be applied to their transcript and counted toward their MPH.
