 - Highlight your topic and the public health problem it addresses.
 - Background
 - Objective
 - Significance and Relevance
- Solution/Innovation Proposed (10 pts)
- Approach (10 pts)
 - Describe how you plan to address this problem
- Impact: (10 pts)
 - How would you assess?
- Sustainability: (10 pts)
 - How will you propose the sustainability of the solution?
