- One of the 27 amendments of the U.S Constitution
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
- Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VII, Equal Employment Opportunities)
- Individuals with Disabilities Education Act
- Voting Rights Act of 1965

Guidelines for poster board:

- The name of your amendment/act
- What year was it established/became a law?
- Definition of your amendment/act (what does your law state).
- A definition of your amendment/act <u>IN YOUR OWN WORDS</u>. What does it mean to you?
- Who was the President at the time your amendment or act became a law?
- A court case (preferably a Supreme Court Case) that involved your amendment/law.

CONTINUE ON BACK

- The name and date of the court case.
- Who won the court case?
- 3 pictures that represent your amendment or law.

Please try your best to fill the majority of your poster board. The less white, the better. You have the option of typing and printing out your words/information, writing them in marker, cutting and pasting, glitter, etc. The only thing I ask is that you do not use regular pencils and pens to write on your poster board.
